

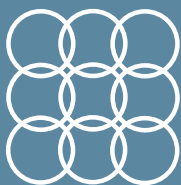
Health Care Home

- Accessible: You can contact your care team and receive care when you need it
 - Patient-Centered: You and your family are an important part of your health care team
 - Continuous: You regularly see the same care providers
 - Comprehensive: Most of the health care services you receive are provided in one location
 - Coordinated: Your health care team works together to coordinate all the care you need and keeps a central medical record of all your health information
 - Compassionate: Your well-being is the highest priority
 - Culturally Competent: Your cultural and religious beliefs are respected
 - Reliable: You can expect evidence-based care from your team, along with resources to teach you how to manage your own health care needs
